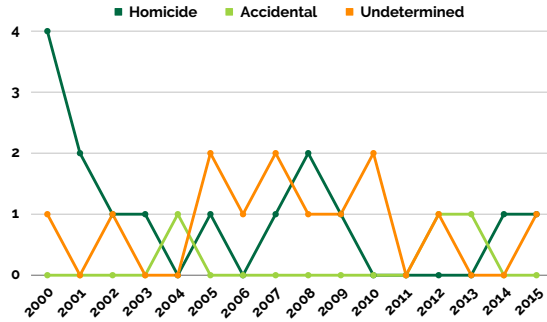
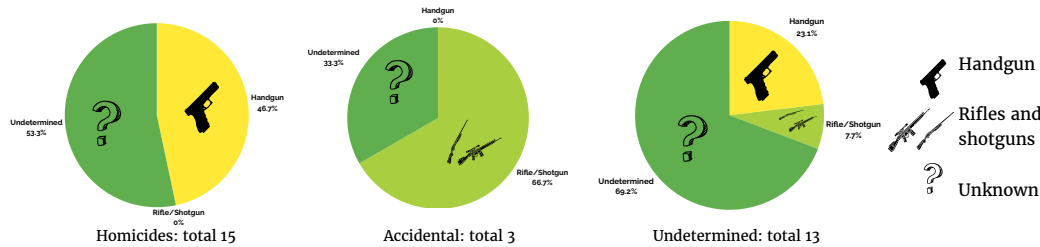




### Evolution of homicides and accidents with firearms (2000-2015) <sup>1</sup>

### Mass Shootings since 2000 <sup>2</sup>

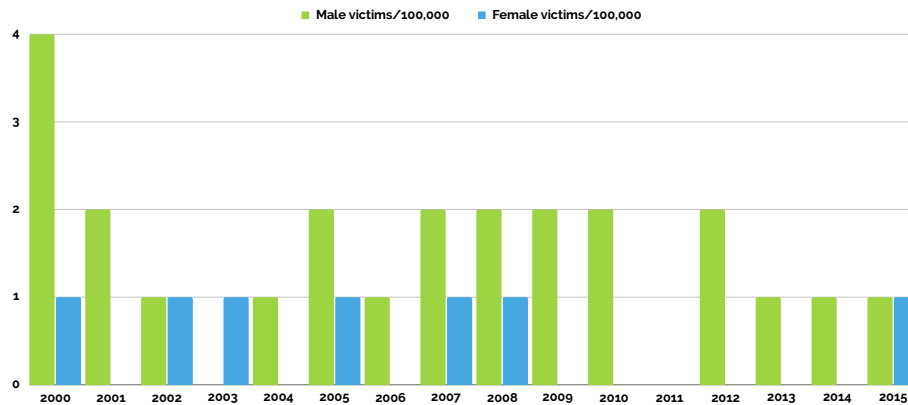

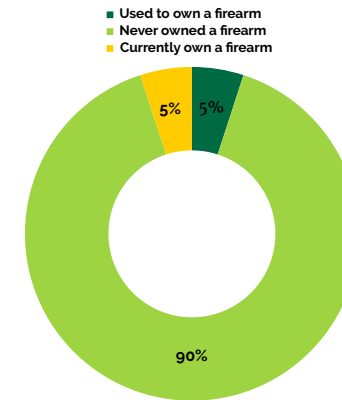

However, the scope will be further widened to include multiple perpetrators, "shootings that occur in the public and/or semi-public space, perpetrated by one offender and resulting in three or more randomly selected victims, with at least one fatality. The term victim refers to those fatally shot and those injured; however, it does not include the perpetrator". 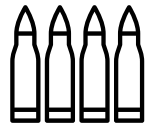

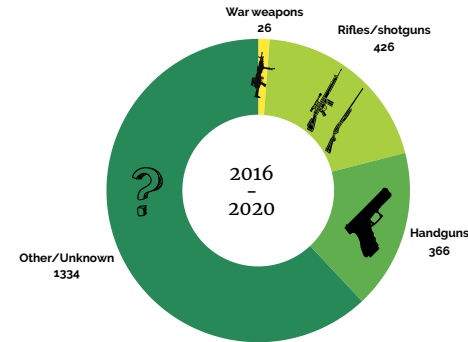

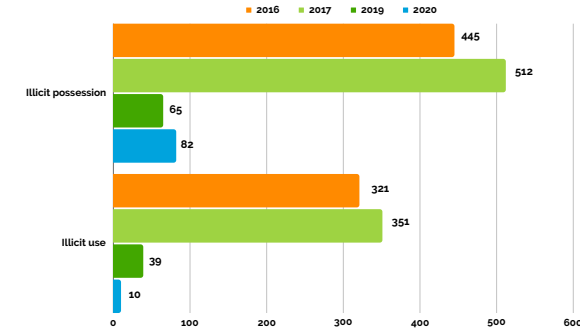

## Trafficking



While the illicit firearms market is very small in Luxembourg, this activity seems to be part of a wider transnational supply network for neighboring countries, and not for the internal market.<sup>8</sup>



Every year, weapons are seized by the authorities in connection with the drug trafficking market.<sup>9</sup>

## Possession



In Luxembourg, whoever wishes to possess a firearm is required to seek authorisation from the Ministry of Justice. The usual reasons stated are recreational shooting, hunting, collecting, or inheritance.<sup>10</sup>



According to the Small Arms Survey, in 2017 in Luxembourg there were 86,000 registered firearms against 24,000 unregistered ones.<sup>11</sup>
